WAMDSAD PLAN FOR 2012 PARALYMPICS

With the Beijing Paralympics due to start within the next three months, WAMDSAD, the Maidenhead based multi-sports club for the disabled, have announced early arrangements for London 2012 in four years' time.

An official statement from LOGOC, the organising body for the 2012 Games, has announced that the Windsor Ascot Maidenhead District Sports Association for the Disabled has been included within the London 2012 Pre-games Training Camp Guide that will be circulated to all countries intending to participate in those games. It is from that guide that those countries will select venues at which their competitors will train prior to the events themselves. WAMDSAD has been included for the sports of Paralympic archery and boccia.

Mike Davis, Head of Operations at WAMDSAD, said: "We are naturally delighted that our application for inclusion in the guide has been successful as it reflects strongly on the efforts of our members, sponsors and supporters in developing our club and its facilities as a centre of excellence for disability sport. We look forward very much to receiving approaches from visiting teams and assisting them in their preparations for the Games in due course".
